THE AUTOMOBILE GALLERY TO PRESENT BEAUTIFUL MUSEUM CLASSIC CARS AT BOTH THE KIWANIS AND COOL CITY CAR SHOWS

August 5, 2020, Manitowoc, Wis. The Automobile Gallery & Event Center of Green Bay will be featuring some of their museum’s classic cars at the Kiwanis Car, Motorcycle, and Vintage Camper show on August 9 in Manitowoc as well as the Cool City Classic Car Show in Two Rivers on August 15. These two premiere car shows in the area are happy to feature the museum at both of these shows.

Launched in 2016, The Automobile Gallery occupies a building that was home to Denil Cadillac, a historic Green Bay dealership between 1958 and 1997. The once gleaming, state-of-the-art dealership sat empty and abandoned for nearly two decades until William “Red” Lewis, a Green Bay native and innovate entrepreneur, was inspired to concert the deteriorating building into an award-winning gallery for automobiles that integrated event and meeting spaces. The lighting, décor, and arrangement have been designed with an intention to maintain a sharp focus on the cars themselves.
